

Legislative Initiatives

- **Bill:** <u>25-0854</u> -On July 14, City Council unanimously passed updates to the Neglected and Derelict Buildings Ordinance to crack down on unsafe properties. The changes will give the city stronger enforcement tools, including higher fines, remedial action plans, and legal options. The ordinance and its enforcement mechanisms will take effect February 1, 2026
- **Bill: <u>25-1002</u>-**On July 28, City Council referred a Charter amendment to the November 4, 2025, ballot that would change the name of the Department of Excise and Licenses to the Department of Licensing and Consumer Protection
